Schiphol Airport (AMS) is the nearest airport for international flights.

It is located at 55 kms. from Utrecht (about 35 minutes by intercity train service – about €9 for a single ticket).

Lunches and dinners

You will have your KA1 grant budget for your accommodation including meals. In the area around the venue there are few shops and no restaurants. Moreover, bringing your own food to the venue and eating it there is not appreciated by the venue's owners. That is why a Dutch lunch of "broodjes" salads and organic fruit is served on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available all day during these course days and on Saturday.

For the Utrecht package participants will be billed €107 (including 9% VAT) by Euneos. The package consists of 4 lunches and tea, coffee and biscuits throughout course days at the venue. Compared to prices in other venues and places in Utrecht and the rest of The Netherlands this is extremely good value for money. You will be sent the invoice for the Utrecht package in April 2019.
