

Practical information about Euneos course 'eAssessment' in Funchal, Madeira (Portugal)

Course dates: 18-24 March 2018

Arrival date in Funchal: Sunday 18 March late afternoon.

Departure from Funchal: Saturday 24 March.

The distance between Chr. Ronaldo Madeira Airport and Funchal is about 20 km, Aerobus connects to Funchal once every hour, ticket costs 5 EUR (see the Aerobus schedule: <https://www.sam.pt/en/aerobus-information.html>). Taxi ride would cost 25-30 EUR.

Transport costs are not included in the course fee, Euneos will not organise your transfers between airport and your hotel.

This institute has a modern building at the Technopol grounds and is situated at about 2.5 km from the Funchal city centre. On the map, it might look easy distance to walk from the city centre, but be aware: the streets are winding uphill.

The course will start on Sunday afternoon 18:00 with an opening session in a cafe at the city centre (the exact venue will be announced a week before by Mart Laanpere).

We'll book tables at the nearby restaurant for welcome dinner (not included in course fee).

Day 2-5 of the course (Monday-Thursday) will take place in the M-ITI.

Day 6 (Friday) will take place in Basic Education and Secondary School of Dr. Ângelo Augusto da Silva (address: Rua do Comboio 50, 9050-069 Funchal)

Day 7: (Saturday) final day. Details about the morning programme will be announced at a later date

Each participant of the eAssessment course is expected to bring their own laptop or tablet computer, which can be a Mac, Android or Windows.

We do not provide laptops or computers. There is WiFi at the course venue and in the hotel.

Accommodation

There are many hotels and AirBnB housing options in Funchal.

Lunches and dinners

You will have your KA1 grant budget for your accommodation including meals.

From Monday to Thursday we will have lunches and coffee breaks in the M-ITI cafeteria (expecting **7-9 euros per lunch**). On Friday, a school lunch will be an option.

You are free to have your dinner where you like, none of the dinners are included in the course fee or organised by Euneos. The city centre offers a lot of restaurants and we will publish some suggestions later on.

Excursion and cultural programme.

Euneos will organise for course participants an optional half-day bus tour to East and North coasts of the Madeira island, it will cost about 25 EUR per person.
