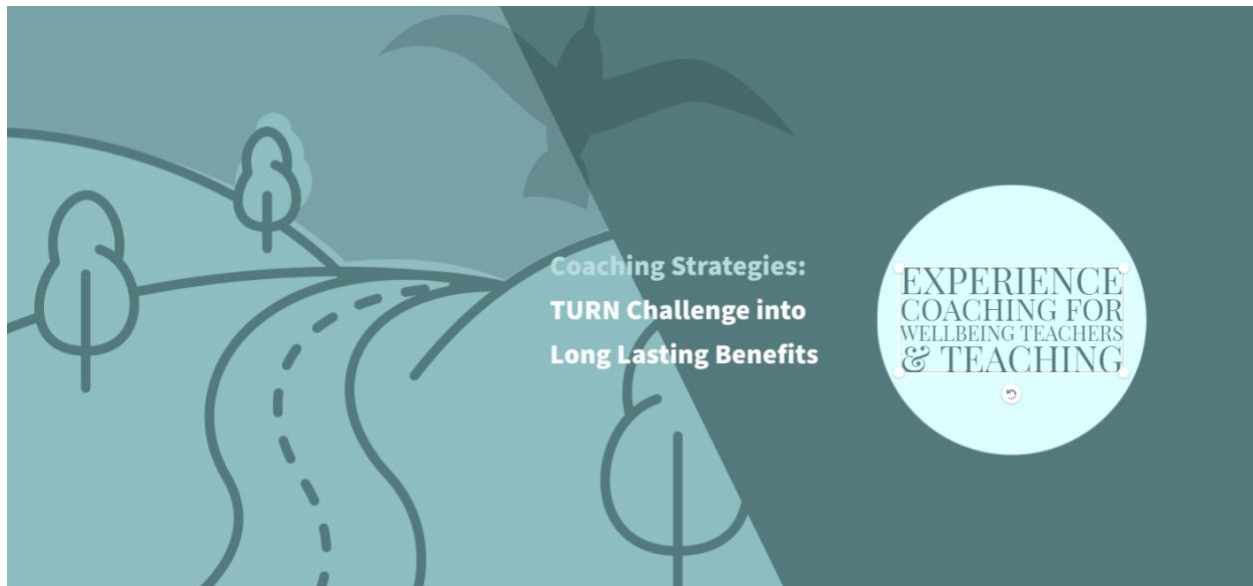


Coaching Strategies for teachers: Turn Challenge into Long Lasting Benefits

This course will:

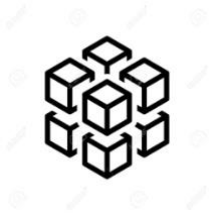
- Support your reflection & mindfulness
