### **This course will:**

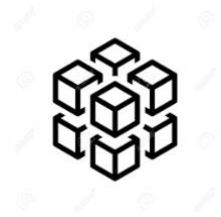
- Relate to your most important and relevant objectives for teaching integrated( 21<sup>st</sup> century skills)
